

## **BY LAWS, ARTICLE II. SECTION 12 ATTACHMENT**

### **HALL OF FAME COMMITTEE**

A list of criteria shall include accomplishments and activities related to the League. The list shall consist of, but not be limited to the following:

1. Elected league official
2. Division Representative
3. Serve as committee chair
4. Serve as committee member
5. Serve as a team manager
6. Serve as a player representative
7. Team player, demonstrating ability to encourage and promote team harmony and a positive influence on the league in general
8. Obtain sponsors
9. Recruit members
10. Advance and promote the league
11. Skill level of play
12. Serve as umpire

Nominating procedure: (1) the process shall remain private and confidential; (2) any league member may nominate a current or former league member for Hall of Fame recognition; (3) at a minimum, the individual making the nomination should include all accomplishments within the established criteria; (4) the nomination will then be presented to the Division representative; (5) following a due diligence review, the Division representative shall forward or reject the nomination.

If the nomination is forwarded to the Committee (still anonymously), the Committee shall consider the nomination accordingly. After a reasonable review a vote will be taken. Each committee member shall have one vote, except the President who shall vote only to break a tie.

A person elected to the Hall of Fame shall receive recognition with the presentation of a citation from the league President at the annual banquet and his name added to the "Hall of Fame" plaque.
